The month of Muharram is a period of fasting, prayers, and refrain (from any joyous event). Muslims usually get together on this day to mourn the death of Imam Hussein, peace and blessings be upon him. To honour his martyrdom, they express sadness and grief in many ways. Muharram-ul-Haram or the month of Muharram is the first month of the Islamic calendar. It is the start of the Islamic new year, and the tenth day of Muharram is known as the Day of Ashura. On this day, the Muslim honours the sacrifice of Imam Hussein, the grandson of Prophet Muhammad. It is the second holiest month in Islam, after Ramadan. As the name of the Prophet Muhammad is attached to it, it is also referred to as 'the sacred month of Allah'.

So, On the occasion of Muharram classes will remain suspended on **July 29, 2023 i.e. Saturday** and will resume from **July 31, 2023 i.e. Monday**.
