

UGC launches 'SheRNI' to ensure women scientist representation.

New Delhi, University Grants Commission's (UGC) Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre on Saturday launched 'She Research Network in India' (SheRNI) to ensure equal representation of women scientists. The UGC said that the SheRNI platform will connect more than 81,000 profiles of Indian women in science and research across various domains.

UGC Chairman Prof. Mamidala Jagadesh Kumar told IANS that UGC wants to ensure equal representation and visibility for the contributions of women scientists and faculty members. "Recognising them is one of the core pillars of a developed India through their research outcomes and scalable solutions," he said. He said that SheRNI confronts stereotypes and will inspire the next generation of female scientists, researchers, and faculty members.
