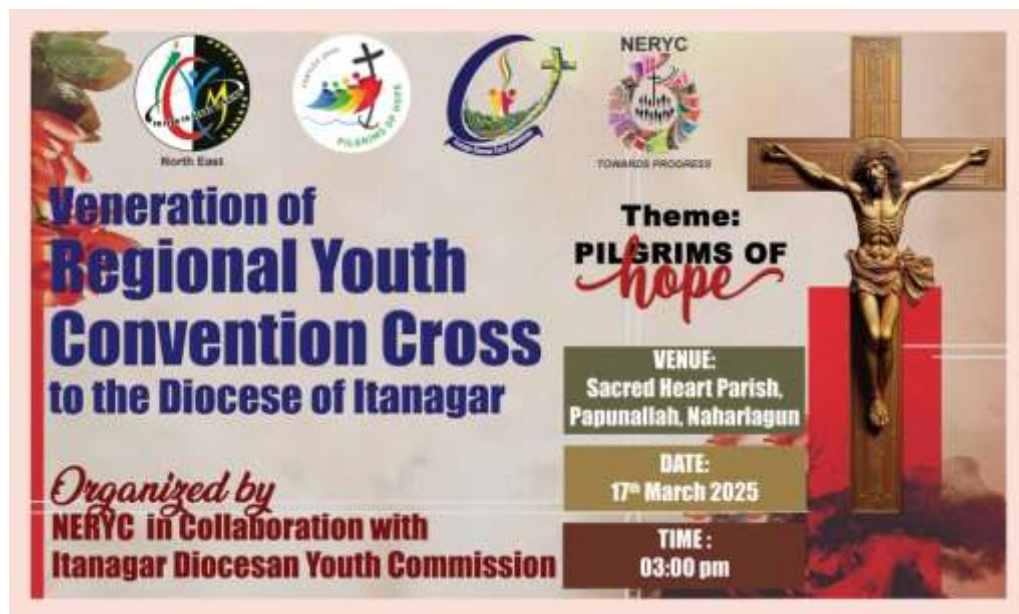


“VENERATION OF THE REGIONAL YOUTH CONVENTION CROSS”

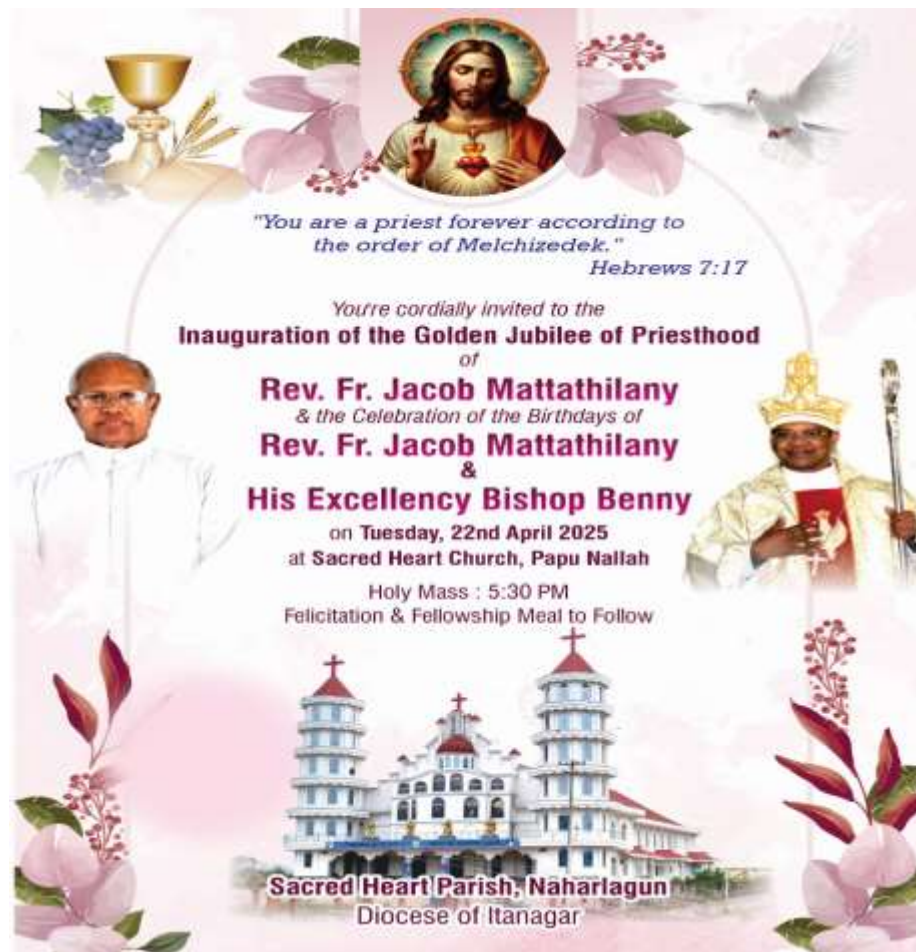
