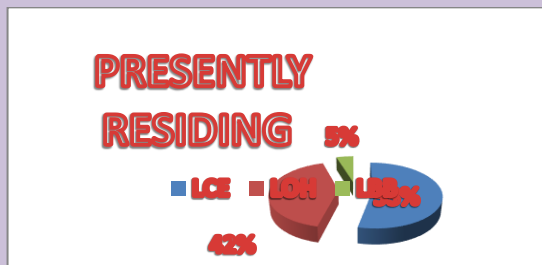
Welcome all. As financial year comes to a close. We all sit back and reflect the year how the year has fared for all of us, , for beautiful children with the Loreto Rainbow Home Program .This program aims to protect, care, educate and empower the most disadvantaged children ..We strive to ensure that these children have access to their rights and that they grow up to be happy responsible and caring citizens .Our mission is to brighten up the life of the most vulnerable children by protecting ,caring and educating them .

1. GENERAL STATUS OF CHILDREN:

In Entally Rainbow Home children are from the age group of 7 -18

Presently the Rainbow children are going to 7 different schools.

2. ACTIVITIES:

NUTRITION CARE:

“Every time you eat is an opportunity to nourish your body “

Every quarter menu is changed with the involvement of the children. .Presently they are getting milk and fruit every alternate day. Non vegetarian food is provided twice a week, Seasonal vegetables and fruits are provided to the children. Every effort is put to give the children a proper diet.

- ❖ **In Entally Loreto Rainbow there are practically no mal nutritious children. But there are 5 underweight children.**
- ❖ **.Presently for breakfast two days breakfast is coming from outside, All the Homes is receiving Bread as Donation from MS Shamoshree.**
- ❖ **Food committee children are doing their part of duties very well. They willingly come forward during the time of food distribution, whenever only donations come or during festive occasions.**

HEALTH: "Take charge of your diet, your health will remain charged

- ❖ **The general health of children is fairly good except a few of them who fell sick.**
- ❖ **Children are maintaining hygiene and cleanliness, and they are keeping in good health... The health in charge does regular health check up of the children. Height, weight and BMI are done once in 3 months but for the underweight children height weight is checked every month. They are provided special diet of Milk, egg and fruits.**
- ❖ **Few children are suffering from abdomen pain; vomiting, Scabies, Dental Problem, Fever, Cough and cold .They are taken to NRS Hospital and KMC Health Center for treatment.**
- ❖ **In the month of February all the Entally children received Worms medicine**
- ❖ **30.11.25-First Aid Session was conducted by the Home Team**
- ❖ **23.1.26-Health Camp was organized by Hind Health Awareness Welfare Society for 68 Rainbow children and staffs at Loreto Rainbow Entally.**



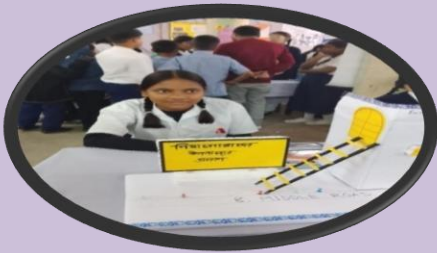
- ❖ **24.1.26- Menstruation Session was arranged by the Health In charge.**

We have around eleven Remedial Teachers who come to teach our children in the subjects they are weak in .They play a pioneering role in making the foundation of our children strong academically They also act as the friend counselor for the children to confide in them .

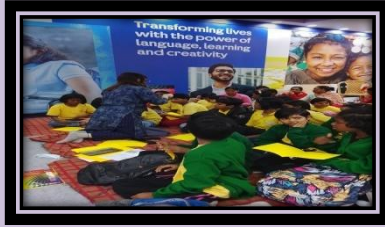

There are ten committees in the Home. The committees keep changing its captains and vice- captains every quarterly. Each committee functions well, they perform their duties and take responsibilities of all functions and celebrations held in the home. Meetings are held regularly.



Apart from the committees, there are BalSabha meetings and gatherings held regularly in the home. There is also the Dainik Sabhas where everyday discussions are held, and we have the monthly meetings too. Balsabha on Educational Motivation was held with the children.

The Suggestion Box is maintained regularly. Problems are solved. The Suggestion Box is opened in front of the children.

Awareness session is held on child marriages health and hygiene, family planning, addiction etc. The parents are updated with their child’s progress, behavior, health and hygiene, nutrition diet etc.
- **The parents help each other in making bank accounts. The parents are advised to make the Birth Certificate and keep all documents safe. It is some time difficult to make the parents understand the value of education while staying in the Rainbow Home.**

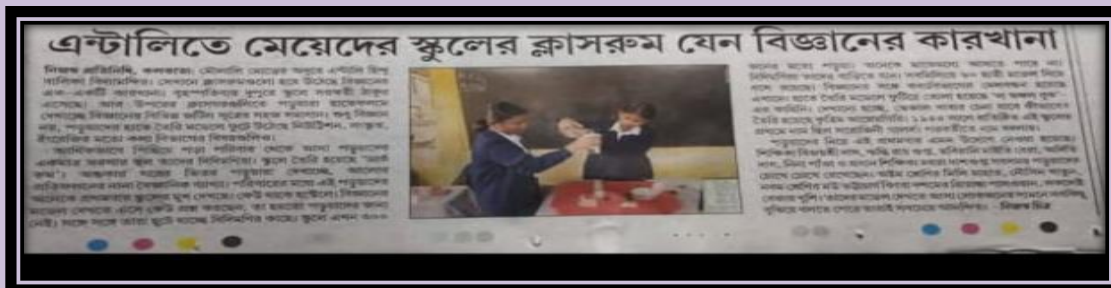
