5. We are pleased to announce that our Parish Feast will be celebrated on Sunday, 19th October 2025. To prepare spiritually for this joyous occasion, a Triduum will be held from Thursday, 16th October, beginning at 6:30 PM with the flag hoisting ceremony, followed by the Holy Eucharist and Novena. During these days, we will have special devotions to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. On the Feast Day, celebrations will commence with a solemn procession at 7:30 AM in front of the Cathedral, led by Most Rev. Anil J.T. Couto. The Mass schedule for the day is as follows: 10:15 AM – Mass in Hindi, 11:30 AM – Mass in English, 4:30 PM – Mass in Hindi and 6:30 PM – Mass in English. All other regular Masses are cancelled on this day, including those at the Mass centers. Lunch coupons for the Parish Feast are available at Rs. 100 per person. Kindly purchase them in advance for yourself and your family. All BEC leaders are requested to bring the picture of your patron saint to be carried during the procession. Let us come together as a community in faith and joy to celebrate this special day.
6. We will be celebrating **Mission Sunday** on **26th October**. Mission Sunday calendars are available for **Rs. 20** each. You are encouraged to collect one for your family, along with a **Mission Sunday envelope**. Please return the envelopes with your generous contributions by **26th October**. There will also be a **second collection** on Mission Sunday in support of the Missions. To mark this occasion, various **Parish associations** and **BEC units** will be organizing food and other stalls outside the church. We request your kind support and generous participation in making this event a success.
